Both the institutions have found it mutually beneficial to explore cooperative activities for the following purposes:

- 1) Collaboration in academic activities between Vignan University, Guntur, India and Sirte University, Sirte, Libiya and visits of the officials of the universities to facilitate the collaboration activities,
- 2) To undertake training programmes of mutual interest for undergraduate and post graduate students in the field of Power Engineering, Communication Engineering, Hydrological and Irrigation Engineering, Production Engineering, Transmission Engineering, Environmental Engineering and any other disciplines mutually agreed upon through specially designed curriculum at Vignan University, Guntur, India for the benefit of students of Sirte University, Sirte, Libiya,
- 3) Exchange of faculty/ research students and use of facilities available at both the Institutions and associated institutions,
- 4) Organization of joint Training Programs/Workshops/Seminars/Meetings,
- 5) Collaboration in Research activities between both the Universities

It is understood that the details of joint activities, terms and conditions for such activities, arrangements for specific visits, exchange of faculty/students and all other form of cooperation will be decided on mutually agreeable terms for each specific case.
